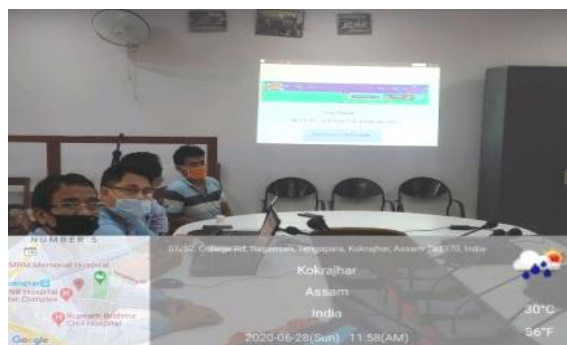
OBSERVATION OF WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY

ONLINE QUIZ COMPETITION

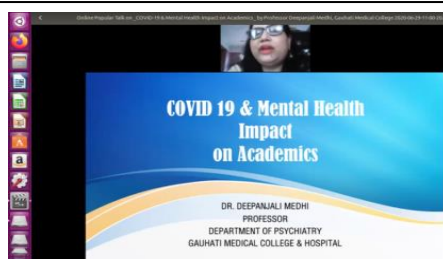

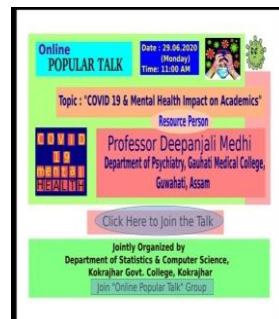
Technical Support Team seen managing Online Open Quiz Competition

ONLINE POPULAR TALK



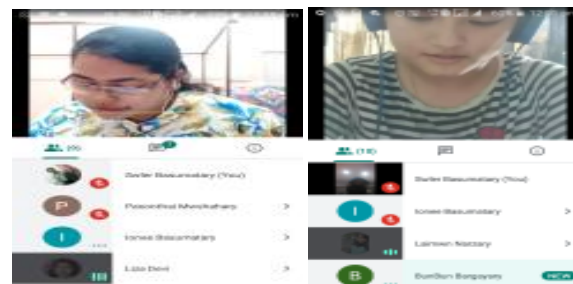
Prof. Deepanjali Medhi seen delivering her lecture online
