Structured Students Feedback on Curriculum:

To obtain Structured Students Feedback on Curriculum during the academic year 2018-19, IQAC of Kokrajhar Govt. College designed a questionnaire. This printed questionnaire was distributed to the Under Graduate students (Major Course) 6th Semester, and Post Graduate 4th Semester students of Chemistry, English, Bodo and Mathematics. Major course was introduced in Sociology in 2017-18; therefore, questionnaire was given to 4th semester students of Sociology major. Among these, 278 Nos. of under Graduate students and a few Post Graduate students submitted their responses.

To get a neutral, unbiased and objective response from the respondents, they were not asked to write their names in the questionnaire. Moreover, the questionnaire was submitted by the students in a drop box provided by IQAC for this survey.

The questionnaire was prepared covering various aspects of curriculum, learning and evaluation. There were 10 questions each with five responses out which the respondent was asked to tick the response which he/she considered to be the most appropriate. The responses were rated in the weight age 1 to 5 with the legends "Poor", "Average", "Good", "Very Good", and "Excellent" respectively. There was no open end question in the questionnaire.

The questionnaire submitted by the students to IQAC was analysed thoroughly and quantitatively by a committee formed by the Principal headed by Dr. Hemanta Kumar Das, Associate Professor of the Department of Assamese of the College. The committee took the utmost care in tabulating the various aspects of the questionnaires and finally plotted the ratings into comprehensive bar diagram by using scientific graphing program Origin 6.1. The bar diagrams were drawn with "No. of question" as abscissa and "Average response" as ordinate of coordinate system. The bar diagrams illustrates responses of students of Kokrajhar Govt. College regarding the Curriculum studied by them.







Assamese:





Bodo:





Bengali:





Botany:





Chemistry:





Computer Science:





Education:





Economics:





English:





Geography:





<u>Hindi:</u>





History:





Mathematics:





Philosophy:





Physics:





Political Science:






Sociology:


Note: This analysis is done by using data submitted by Semester IV students of Sociology Major. Major course was introduced in Sociology department in the acdemic year 2017-18.
