Length of the manuscript should not be more than 4000 words. The manuscript should carry a brief abstract not exceeding 250 words and should include a maximum of 5 key words.

The font style of the manuscript should be in Times New Roman and the font size should be 12-point size. The Main Heading should be short and clearly defined in bold.

The entire manuscript except the title should be single spaced on A4 sheet, alignment- Justified and Margin should be 1 inch.

Figures and Tables should be placed as close as possible to where they are cited.

References are to be cited in APA style, 7th edition format. No objection certificate indicating the paper has not been previously submitted or published to another journal or book and Plagiarism

Certificate having a maximum of 10 per cent similarity index must be attached along with full paper.
